Christmas ride

Having done my last ride in October I'm always itching to get out again and the Christmas ride at Symonds Yat is perfect.

We only live 15 mins from the venue so a Sunday lazy lie in was still achieved!!

It's a lovely venue with hard parking and a choice of distances, we chose to do the 20km.

She set off with gusto, too polite to buck but showing her enthusiasm by letting out a few screeches.

We were one of the last groups to leave the venue so we pushed on ahead, the tracks were riding lovely, Pagan is used to riding forest tracks.

We caught up with some riders and passed them with care, I assume they headed for home when the ride distance split as we didn't see them again.

The river was full and flowing fast as we trotted along side of it, it always looks so cold at this time of year.

Then an uphill track away from the river to where the distances split again, we all continue on the 20km route, by this time one of our party had ridden ahead as her pony was keen to go.

The three of us left, kept up a good pace and there were brief spells of dryness as we rode along. We were soon back at the venue, untacking and collecting our rosette and a carrot for Pagan, which she appreciated !!

Andrew had gone home to keep the dogs company while I rode the route, he was back, hitched up and patiently waiting with a cup of tea for me.

Me and Pagan thoroughly enjoyed this ride and we both left with a smile, the new coat performed well as I was kept completely dry.

- * Ride Organisers will not get a Helping Occasion under this scheme as they will still receive a free Group ride entry as previously.
- ❖ Each volunteer giving at least a full half day will be recorded as a helping occasion.
- ❖ For those that give a full half days volunteering prior to or after the ride (e.g. route marking or setup etc) will also receive a helping occasion (an additional one if they were also a volunteer on the day).
- The consideration of what is required to be "a full half day" will be at the ride or event Organiser's discretion.

There is no expiry date on these volunteer occasions so they will continue with a Reward every 6th occasion until the scheme is terminated by the OD committee. The Christmas Cracker


It was New Years Eve, I was only just recovering from the indulgences of Christmas and the weather was yet again forecast to be wet! Did I really want to clean all that mud off Puzzle and head off into the forest for a wet ride my husband asked? People on my yard seemed to revel in asking me 'have you seen the weather forecast for today?!' But I had the faith, the forest would deliver and I was rewarded with a fantastic ride.

On arrival I was given last minute instructions on a tricky path with a fallen tree and then I was good to go. We set off alone in damp and chilly conditions and were very soon joined by Fiona on Goofy who were happy to ride with us. 10 minutes in from teaming up I realised why Fiona's horses name was familiar. I was momentarily star struck to be riding with a Team GB rider but Fiona immediately put me at ease with her friendly nature. This fortuitous encounter turned a lovely training ride into an amazing tutorial for me, still inexperienced in endurance riding. Fiona set a steady pace perfect for so early in the season. We talked about winter training and how she brings her horses back into work as we rode the first section of the ride which took us through lots of steady forest tracks before dropping down next to the river. I'm not sure I've ever seen The Wye so full or running that fast. By coincidence this was where I was in deep conversation with Fiona on all things to do with water and cooling horses at vet gates and at the end of events.

The next section of the ride became more nadgery with grassier tracks leading up to some beautiful views. There were frequent opportunities for some steady canter work which the horses really enjoyed and Puzzle practiced her collected canter behind Goofy. Despite the now falling rain it was surprisingly good ground with very little deep or slippery conditions. Just as we were beginning to feel decidedly damp the rain very helpfully stopped and it even started feeling a little warmer.

The final section of the ride took us back down towards the river where the discussion turned to the fallen tree. Where exactly had Cecilia and Belinda said it was? Were we going to try getting

under it? Were we going to dismount? With Goofy being the same height as Puzzle but Fiona a little less rotund than myself, I decided if she got under safely I just needed to hang off the side of Puzzle a bit to avoid a 'Winnie the Pooh stuck moment!' As we came up the track the offending tree appeared suddenly from around a hidden corner. I had no time to think really before Fiona disappeared under its hanging foliage. I was slightly



perturbed that she appeared to have squirmed under with virtually no room for error. I breathed



in (as if that'd help () wishing fervently that I'd eaten a few less mince pies over Christmas but it was fine - Puzzle was calm, I leaned precariously and we emerged safely the other side. It was a short hop home from there and we arrived back almost dry with happy horses. A perfect ride in great company.

Once again I would like to thank the people in our group who tirelessly organise and marshal rides for us to enjoy. And this one really was a 'cracker!'
