Pegasus: Jupiter and Beyond.....

Pegasus, we probably all know, was the divine winged horse beloved of the Gods. The name Pegasus, as some of us possibly do not know, was also the name of a satellite launched by the Saturn rocket used in the early 1960s at the height of the "space race"... hold that thought.....

I am not sure how many of you take the same perverse delight as I do in calculating the costs of your rosettes. I started this endurance based side-show a few years ago after a Golden Horseshoe outing. The Horseshoe was wonderful as usual, but one rainy afternoon soon afterwards I idly totted up the rough costs of the trip. I had done the 2 day 80km and for that had rented a large cottage (all the small ones had gone), taken, fed and watered the crew (of course), had paid stabling and turnout for my steed and stayed in total for 4 nights. Plus diesel, entry fees etc.. I calculated it had cost about £10 per mile ridden... fortunately it was cheaper in kilometres, at £6.29 per km ridden. After the shock, I realized this was a good game so have strived to beat my personal best: so far a trip to do Cerne Giant in Dorset, with overnight stay and crew (and having got there, deciding to do the short pleasure ride rather than the 40km competitive ride) is the clear winner with £20 per mile ridden. It is also a great ride and worth every penny. Obviously local rides with no crew are the most economical at usually less than £1 per mile ridden. I am not sure what the aim of all this is ,but as people say somewhat pointlessly "it makes you think..."

What also made me think was reading an article recently that the USA are planning to send a rocket to Mars (and back) at a cost of £700 million. OOO that's a lot I thought: then I remembered from my days when I was interested in astronomy that Mars was "only" about 140 million miles away, so 280 million miles there and back... so that is £2.50 per mile. Cheaper than my rosettes!!

Obituary

Margaret Riley 1937-2022

Margaret Riley has passed away aged 85 yrs. Margaret started riding and endurance riding as a mature woman, on a Welsh/arab chestnut pony.

It all started when Hereford & District R.C. put on a series of rides, one month apart of 10, 15, 20 and 25 miles, optimum speed 7.5 m.p.h. Those nearest the time had a rosette, and those riding all 4 rides at optimum time were a "champion". Margaret won her first ever rosette and it was a red one, she was ecstatic!

She joined B.H.S long distance riding and rode mainly BBQ and BB finals. Riding a PR from Lesley Dunn's field at the Narth, Monmouth, we were invited to attend a meeting at the Narth village hall at a later date to discuss the formation of a new Endurance Horse and Pony Society (E.H.P.S) group.

Hosted by Fiona Wilton (the first Chair person) Freda Waycott and Lesley Dunn, Offa's Dyke Group of EHPS was formed.

Margaret became a committee member and for many, many years Group secretary, she helped at rides, including the 2-3 day rides from Ludlow racecourse, helping Margaret McKiddie.

In 1990 Sweden hosted the first World Equestrian Games, (W.E.G.) and G.B sent teams including endurance. Margaret, with her friend Mary Williams attended as crew to Jane Donovan riding Idris. Jane won an individual silver medal and the team won gold.

Margaret won the Queens award for nursing and was a theatre sister at Hereford Hospitals.

She was mother to four children and a grandmother, her husband Les predeceased her, he also was a stalwart helper for O.D. in many different roles.

- * Ride Organisers will not get a Helping Occasion under this scheme as they will still receive a free Group ride entry as previously.
- * Each volunteer giving at least a full half day will be recorded as a helping occasion.
- * For those that give a full half days volunteering prior to or after the ride (e.g. route marking or setup etc) will also receive a helping occasion (an additional one if they were also a volunteer on the day).
- * The consideration of what is required to be "a full half day" will be at the ride or event Organiser's discretion.

There is no expiry date on these volunteer occasions so they will continue with a Reward every 6th occasion until the scheme is terminated by the OD committee. We hope this new initiative will benefit and incentivise volunteering, and demonstrate how much we appreciate you giving up your time for everyone's pleasure.
